Also running lunch club, sports club and intra school competitions. Main focus is staff CPD.</p>	<p>£8,500.00</p>	<p>Mr Fox continues to be a mainstay of our P.E development. Uptake from staff has continued. Mr Fox is working less with whole classes as the confidence of staff has increased. Increasingly, he is working with targeted groups of children and teams. 82% of children were reported as working at national standard in P.E in the last academic year.</p>

She also runs an after school club on Wednesday afternoons.</p> <p>Rachel Mellor worked with 15 Year 5 and 6 children to train them for a duathlon event. This was successful for KS1 Sportshall Athletics and is something we will continue in the future.
