Please find on the next page an outline of our summer term topics. On Tuesday 8th July we are taking the children on a fantastic historically themed educational visit to Brigantium Roman settlement. The children will spend the day as Roman soldiers and be fully immersed in what life would be like in Roman times. As part of our PSHE learning this term, we are taking part in road safety training with the Kirklees Road Safety Team.

In the first half of the summer term, the children have Forest School sessions with Ruth Patterson. These sessions are wonderful at developing the children's collaborative skills and problem solving, as well as providing them with time to re-establish their social connections. Forest School activities are carefully planned to support our learning in class.

In the first half term, the children have an indoor PE session on Friday. In the second half term, we will have an outdoor PE session on Thursday with Mr Fox. The children will need to come in appropriate outdoor PE kit on these days.

The summer term is when our Relationship and Sex education curriculum is timetabled, this is something we plan to deliver in the second half of the term. The lessons will cover: Difference: male and female, respecting others' personal space and family difference. Further details of the material covered can be found on our school website, or by speaking to any of the Year 3 teaching staff.

Thank you for your continued support with your child's reading, spelling and times tables homework, it makes a huge difference to your child's interaction with their learning. Regular practice on Times Table Rockstars will increase the children's confidence and recall of times table facts, in readiness for their move to Year 4. Please encourage / remind your children to log in and practise at least once a week.

Science	We begin the new term learning about Animals Including
	Humans. We then move on to learn about plants.

	outdoor learning and planting.
RE	This half term we are exploring the Understanding
	Christianity unit, 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'
	Next half term we will be thinking about, 'Who can
Computing	inspire us?' We will continue to use Purple Mash to develop
Computing	knowledge and understanding of computing, with a focus
	on email and coding.
History	The Roman Empire and its impact on this country.
Geography	This is a comparison of the counties of Cornwall and
	West Yorkshire, looking at location, physical and human
	geography.
Design	The children will complete a textiles project linked to
Technology	topic work.
Art	Creative projects will link to our work on environmental
	themes and responses to the work of artists.
French	Topics will include dates and the weather.
Music	We are learning to play the ukulele.
PSHE	This term we are learning about road safety and basic
	first aid. After half term, we will be discussing how to
	respond to change. In sex and relationships education,
	we will be considering valuing difference and keeping safe.
