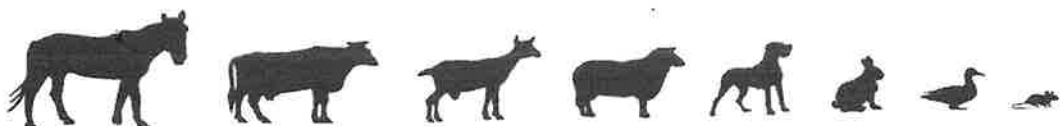

No entrance fee is required.

Our marquee will show your works for all to see. A group of specialist judges will view the exhibits and provide rosettes for exhibits which show high skill and impact.

All you need to do is complete the Entry form provided on the website honleyshow.co.uk/competing/Handicrafts. Study the schedule 2025 and complete the entry form. Return the form to the Secretary of Handicraft Section details on the entry form. Make sure you show details of the size of your entry and the medium you have used. Exhibits need to be brought to the marquee either Friday 27th June before 6pm or Saturday 28th June morning before 8.45 am.
