# Reading at Home

 $\frac{2}{3}$ Reading at home with an adult is crucial to all children's reading development. Please try to read with your child for 10 minutes a day. This could be any form of reading, not just a  $\stackrel{\bigstar}{\sim}$ school reading book. Your child could read a shopping list, magazine, menu etc. Anything that engages your child to read, counts! Please record this in your child's yellow reading record so we can see the lovely reading you are doing. The Little Wandle book that your  $^lpha$ child brings home from school should be read with at least 90% fluency and therefore may seem quite easy! Our aim is for the children to read these books fluently, with ★understanding and expression. They should have already read the book in school and be  $\stackrel{\bigstar}{\sim}$  practising their fluent reading aloud at home. This practice is important and is key to developing confidence and fluency.

#### **☆**Homework

\*should know what to do when they come home. They may require adult support at home to complete it and this is okay! Please feel free to add any comments to your child's homework. Occasionally, we may set larger project based work usually over a holiday ★period. Homework will come home in a yellow folder. For now it will consist of a Little Wandle phonics sheet and sometimes a piece of maths work - this will vary week to week.

#### ★PE & Forest School

For this half term, PE is on a Monday with Kirk. Please send your child to school in appropriate outdoor PE kit. Please ensure all earrings are removed for PE. Forest school is ★on a Tuesday with Ruth. Please send your child to school in appropriate Forest School clothing.
